**SCRIPTURE READINGS** PMB pp.153-6 Prf of Temptation p.71 EP2 p.25

Deuteronomy 26:4-10 Moses prescribes the annual ceremony of thanksgiving by the Jewish people for their deliverance from slavery in Egypt and entry into the Promised Land.

Romans 10:8-13 We are saved by faith in Jesus as Lord and in his Resurrection from the dead.

Luke 4:11-13 Jesus is led by the Spirit into the wilderness—a time of preparation for his ministry. The temptations which occur at the end of this time are graphically recounted in Luke, Jesus turns each of them down with a quotation from Scripture.
