Today's Scripture Readings PMB pp.294-8 Prf p.75 EP 1 p.18

Acts 2:1-11 The apostles, baptised with the Holy Spirit, speak in tongues of the marvels of God.

Romans 8: 8-17 If we belong to Christ, it is because we possess his Spirit (ie the Holy Spirit). It is in this sense that we can speak of a "spiritual life".

John 20:19-23 The risen Christ commissions the apostles by the power of the Holy Spirit to go out and preach repentance for the forgiveness of sins.
