Scripture Readings on special pmb 128-129 **EP3 p.28**

Isaiah 8:23-9:3 The people of Galilee who have suffered deportation and slavery will experience liberation and glory in the (distant) future.

1 Cor 1:10-13:17 Factionalism and infighting have taken over the Christians of Corinth. Paul argues for unity in Christ.

Matthew 9:35-7 Jesus in Galilee fulfils Isaiah's prophesy (1R) and calls the first four members of the Twelve.
