Thursday 25th - 6.00pm Mass in church - **FEAST OF THE ANNUNCIATION OF THE LORD**

Scripture Readings:

Psalm: 39

R./: Here I am, Lord: I come to do your will

Second Reading: Hebrews 10:4-10

Gospel: Luke 1:26-38

Please genuflect during the Creed at the words "and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary and was made man".

Friday 26th - Stations of the Cross will take place at 5.15pm followed by Mass at 6.00pm

Saturday 27th - 10.00 to 11.30 Individual prayer & Exposition.
Please note there will be no Mass via **Zoom** at 5.00pm

Sunday 28th - **PALM SUNDAY** 10.30am in church

There will be no processing and Palms will only be handed out on exit. It is hoped that anyone living near those who are shielding would be kind enough to drop a Palm through their letter box some time during the afternoon before 4.30pm.
In the Gospel the 'crowd' utterances should not be said by the congregation.
