### **Important Notes on Gift Aid and Weekly Envelopes from the Parish Treasurer**

**Gift Aid:** As from 6th April '21, all Gift Aided contributions to the Parish by weekly Envelope or Standing Order will be assigned to the Belmont Abbey Charity instead of the Downside Abbey Charity. All Gift Aid will still be returned to the Parish for Parish use. In due course I will be asking all 'Gift Aiders' to sign a new Declaration nominating the Belmont Abbey Charity.
