RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION UNDER BOTH KINDS IN ST WULSTAN'S

The Catholic Conference of Bishops in England and Wales have recommended that parishes reinstate the distribution of Holy Communion under both species i.e. the Body and Blood of Christ. It is hoped that we can resume this practice on the Saturday/ Sunday, 10th/11th June; the Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

Those members of the parish who are unable to receive the Precious Blood, for any reason, may refrain from doing so. We will require a number of Extra-Ordinary ministers of Holy Communion who will be rostered in to assist at either of the two weekend Masses. This is a very responsible and dedicated ministry in the Church and will entail some training.

CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION ON SUNDAY, 11TH JUNE

Following the 10.30am Solemn Mass on Sunday 11th June, there will be procession along with the Blessed Sacrament around the church of St Wulstan's culminating with a short Benediction in the church before we disperse. Let us take this opportunity to pray that God in His infinite goodness may be gracious to us and bestow His blessings on our families, our parish of St Wulstan's and especially for all those preparing for examinations at this time.

POPE'S PRAYER INTENTION FOR JUNE

The Archdiocese will require names and numbers of candidates to fix a date for the Sacrament.
