My son Mark was diagnosed with MS when he was 30 and has lived with it progressing steadily for 16 years. He was one of RGS's most promising rowers competing at Henley but now he is unable to accompany his 2 children 13 and 15 on bike rides or even walks. The NHS cannot do any more so he has taken the brave step of going to Mexico where they have pioneered stem cell replacement for 20 years. The clinic say that Mark has an 85% chance of the treatment halting the progression of his MS but this comes at an enormous cost - £50,000.

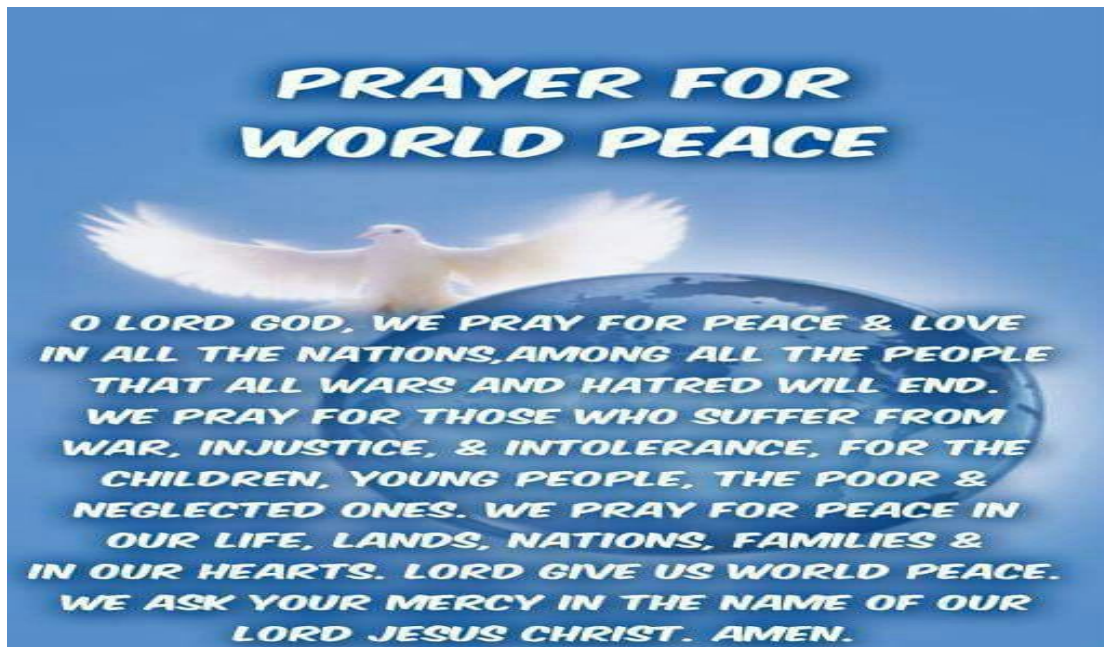
MASS INTENTIONS
