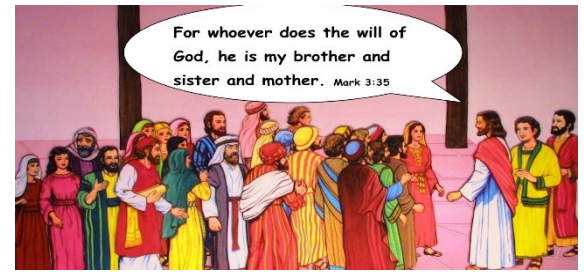

MASS INTENTIONS

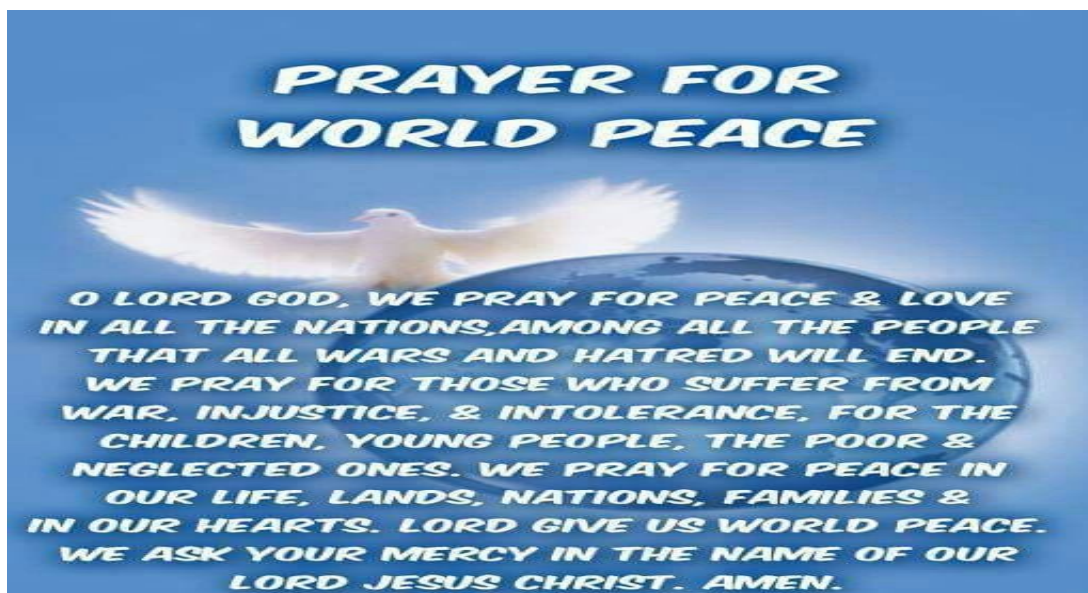
