PRAYING FOR OUR DEARLY DEPARTED LOVED ONES AND ALSO THE SICK

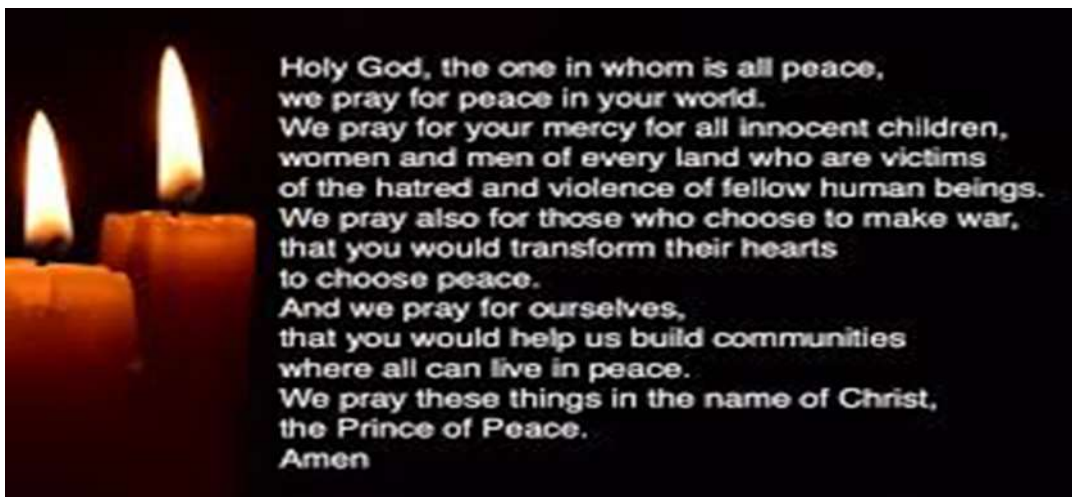
