THE SEVEN SORROWS OF OUR LADY: sometimes symbolized in art by seven swords piercing her heart:

- 1)The prophecy of Simeon (Luke 2:25 ff)
- 2)The Flight into Egypt (Matt 3:13 ff)
- 3)The loss of the Child Jesus (Luke 2:41 ff)
- 4)Mary meets Our Lord on the road to Calvary (4th Station)
- 5)The Crucifixion (Mt.27, Mk.15,Lk.23,Jn.19)
- 6)The descent from the Cross (texts as above)
- 7Burial of Our Lord (texts as above)

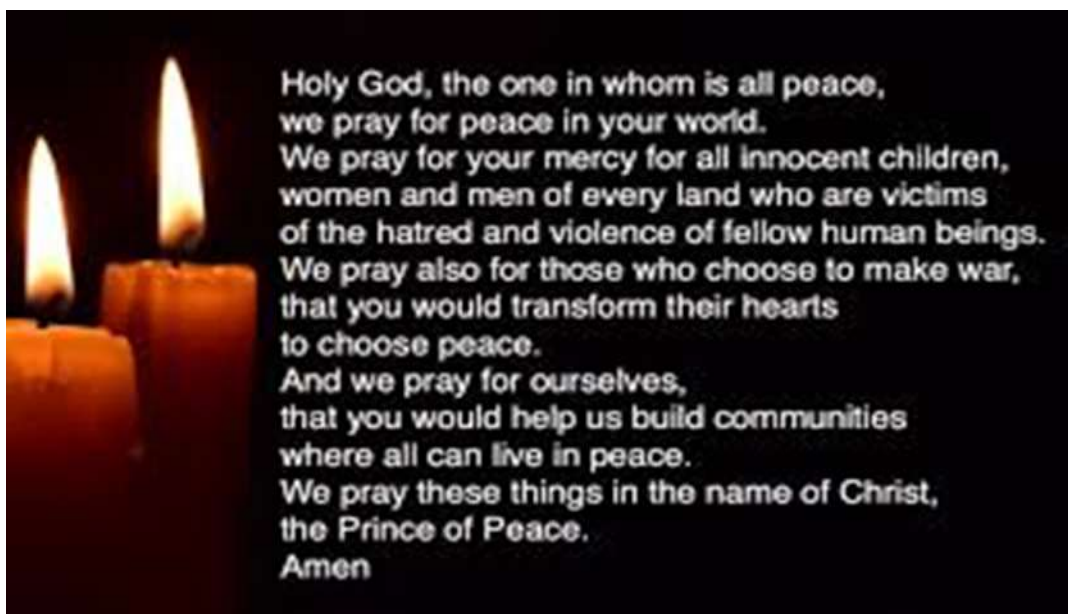
POPE FRANCIS' PRAYER INTENTION FOR SEPTEMBER
