Plenty of parking on Thirlstane Road alongside the Common and Malvern College Cricket Ground.

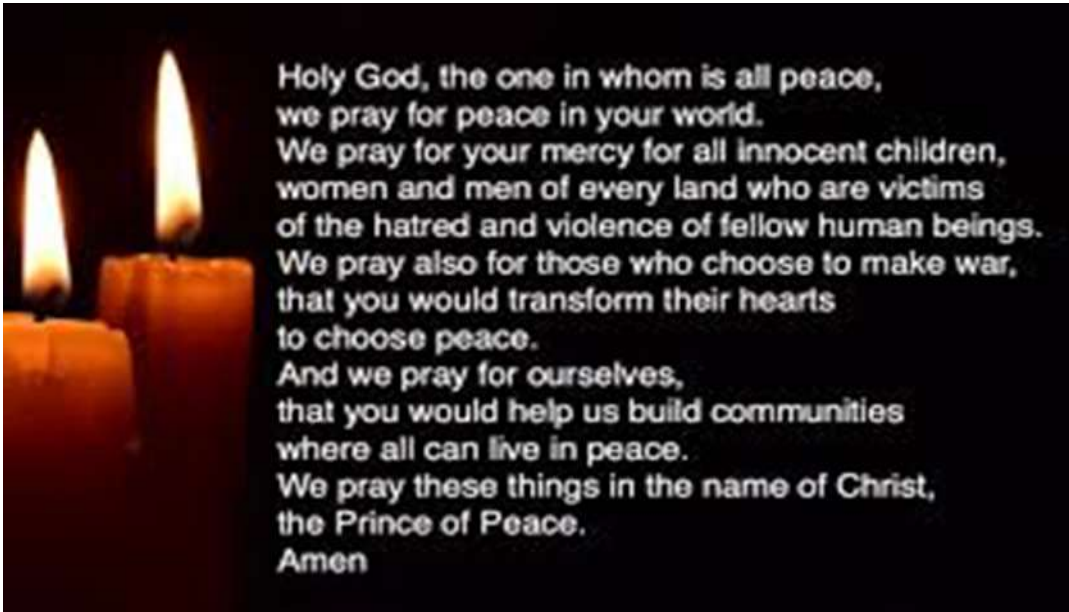
