Today's Scripture Readings: Parish Mass Book pp. 261-3 Prf 3 p.60 Euch.Prayer 3 p.28

Acts 4:8-12 The holy name of Jesus is the only name, of all those given to men in the world, by which we are saved. It is good to use it frequently in prayer, as in the prayer of the Russian pilgrim: "Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on me, a sinner". This is known as the "Jesus Prayer".

1 John 3:1-2 By our baptism we have been adopted as sisters and brothers of Christ, children of God, drawn into the personal love for each other of the Father and Son, which love is the Holy Spirit.

John 10:11-18 The "good" (i.e. "true" or "real") shepherd is intimately connected to his flock.
