
# 2ND COLLECTION NEXT WEEKEND FOR 'PETER'S PENCE'- 29th/30th JUNE

# APPEAL FOR NEW PARISH MASS BOOKS FOR ST WULSTAN'S

Due to the various changes to the Catholic liturgical calendar of Solemnities and added Feasts over the years, the Church in England, Scotland and Wales has revised the current version of the Lectionary and Missal with a New Translation which will come into use at Advent this year, 2024 for all celebrations of the Holy Mass in our churches and chapels nationally. As a result we will be looking to purchase and replace the Parish Mass Books (PMB) in current use with the New translation PMBs which will retail at £5.95/book. These will be into two parts covering the whole of Liturgical Year C. More about this in the next Bulletin.

I wish to thank all our benefactors who have donated generously for the purchase of the New Lectionaries. I will be placing our order in the coming week. God reward you all.
