Acts 10:25-48 Peter has had a dream in which he learns that no food is to be called unclean. The Roman Centurion, Cornelius, has been told in a vision to seek out Peter. This encounter is the result.

1 John 4:7-10 This Christ-centred vision of the world and its redemption is rejected by many of our contemporaries. It is, nonetheless, the faith which brings us to our knees.

John 15:9-17 The continuation of Jesus' discourse after the Last Supper: it is an invitation to share in the love of the Father for the Son and of the Son for the Father. That love is the Holy Spirit.
