Today's Scripture Readings: Parish Mass Book pp. 85-9 Prf. 1 p.53 Euch.Prayer 3 p.27

Exodus 24:3-8 This passage records the institution of the "old" Covenant between Yahweh and Israel

Hebrews 9:11-15 The High Priest of the Temple in Jerusalem used, once a year, to offer sacrifice in the inner sanctum—the "Holy of Holies" for the sins of the People. Christ, our High Priest, went once and for all, through death on the cross, into the very Godhead, the true Holy of Holies.

Mark 14:12-26 The institution of the Eucharist, according to Mark and the other Synoptics, takes place in the course of the Passover meal. The shedding of Christ's blood and his death on the Cross, which take place the next day, are the sacrifice of the new and everlasting Covenant.
