**Today's Scripture Readings:** Parish Mass Book pp. 89-92 Prf. 2 p.54 Euch.Prayer 3 p.27

**Genesis 3:9-15** This prophecy of the enmity between the woman and the serpent is later, in the light of the Incarnation, understood to refer to the Blessed Virgin Mary and Jesus (her offspring).

**2 Corinthians 4:13-5:1** It is worth reading last Sunday's section from 2 Corinthians, where Paul describes us believers as mere vessels of clay (earthenware jars) holding within ourselves the good news of the mystery of God's glory in the face of the risen Christ. It is this faith that Paul preaches to all.

**Mark 3:20-35** Mark's Gospel addresses the question, "Who is Jesus?". His relatives believe he is out of his mind and the Scribes from Jerusalem claim that he is possessed by a devil.
